**Job Title:** Maintenance Apprentice

## **Key Roles and Responsibilities**

- 1. 2 Year Apprenticeship.
- 2. Attend College for one day per week and work four days.
- 3. Learn a wide range of property maintenance skills as well as health and safety.
- 4. Carry out repairs to the fabric of a building, e.g. repairs to walls, doors, doorframes, skirting boards or plaster damage to internal walls.
- 5. Understand and maintain plumbing and drainage systems e.g. WC systems, leaking taps and unblocking drains.
- 6. Understand and maintain electrical distribution, safe repair of electrical installation to legal requirements e.g. replacing damaged sockets, plugs, lights and fuses.
- 7. Understand and maintain plant, safety systems and equipment.
- 8. Understand and maintain grounds and external fabrication of a building, such as drainage and guttering.
- 9. Understand and demonstrate the safe use of hand tools e.g. screwdrivers, power drills, pliers, paper strippers and a variety of other tools used in plumbing and carpentry.
- 10. Carry out repairs and reactive maintenance.
- 11. Assist with the collection of patient medication from the hospital, and undertake the collection of patients notes and medication equipment.
- 12. Take reasonable care for your own safety and the safety of others. Adhere to all Health & Safety requirements, including Covid-19 secure processes and procedures.



13. Promote a culture of continuous learning and development and wellbeing. Identify your own learning and development needs and ensure your mandatory and essential training is up to date. Help to create an environment that is continually critically questioning practice and promoting learning.
