Job Title: Senior Healthcare Assistant - Hospice at Home

Key roles and responsibilities:

- 1. Attend to patients in their own homes, providing personal care such as feeding, washing and repositioning and giving medications.
- 2. Sit with patients to allow families/carers to rest, liaising with the Sister on duty to report changes in condition, a need for medication or to ask for assistance.
- 3. Provide emotional support to families.
- 4. Support Registered Nurses with care after death.
- 5. Promote a culture of continuous learning and development and wellbeing. Identify your own learning and development needs and ensure your mandatory and essential training is up to date. Help to create an environment that is continually critically questioning practice and promoting learning.
- 6. Play an active part in team meetings, attend clinical supervision and ensure your mandatory and other relevant training is kept up-to-date.
- 7. Take reasonable care for your own safety and the safety of others. Adhere to all Health & Safety requirements, including Covid-19 secure processes and procedures.

This list can never be exhaustive but covers most of the work you'll be doing. What it can't replace is talent, initiative and a commitment to great customer service.

Infection Prevention
